### How to Create a Custom Assignment

1. Sign in to the teacher log in of [www.raz-kids.com](http://www.raz-kids.com)
2. Click the “Assignments” tab.
3. Once you’re on the roster, click the blue “Reading” tab.
4. Click the blue “Create a New Custom Assignment” link.
